Delaware Aviation Hall of Fame  
Nominations for Youth Award

The annual “Youth Achievement Award” will be made to the young man or woman who has distinguished himself or herself in aviation training, career development and participation in aviation community activities.

Delaware youths ages 15 through 21 who are pursuing a career in aviation, in the air or on the ground, will be eligible. Non-residents engaged in training and career programs in Delaware are also eligible.

The recognition will be conferred at the annual honors banquet, this year on September 25. Selection will be determined by representatives of five major aviation organizations in the First State: Civil Air Patrol; Delaware Aviation Support (a pilots organization).

Delaware Ninety Nines (women pilots international organization), Air Force Association; and the Delaware chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association.

The panel will be chaired by Ron Mehan, Colonel (Ret.) of Newark, a member of the DAHF Board of Trustees.

Nominations are welcome. The DAHF invites written recommendations from the public. Nominations should not exceed two single-space pages. Supporting documents are welcome. Nominations postmarked no later than June 1, should be sent to Youth Achievement Award, Delaware Aviation Hall of fame, P.O.Box 4303, Greenville, DE 19807 – 0303.
